

Single Application





Single Application

- ▶ Before 2007: two separate parcel registrations (Department Agriculture and Fishery, and Manure Bank)
- ▶ 2007: EPR = one declaration
 - → Single Application with Department
 - × Single parcel registration
 - × Single identification
- Basic payment = Pillar I (Department)
- ▶ AECM (agri environment climate measures) = Pillar II (Department and Flemish Land Agency)
- ▶ N directive = Manure Bank Declaration (Flemish Land Agency)









- ▶ Farmers: Single Application for all exploitations
- Mandate holders: a SA for every farmer for which they have a mandate

- ▶ Identification farmers
- For existing parcels (copy from previous year) and new parcels (take-over, draw, split, join)
 - → Crops
 - → Period of use
 - → Number of acres
 - → Specialised production methodes
 - → Applications: derogation, BKM, ...
 - → Greening
 - → Ecological Focus Area elements
 - → AECM
 - → Management Agreements




Exchange

- ▶ Also exchange with third parties e.g. Eurostat services
- ▶ Every campaign year
 - → Information from Department Agriculture and Fishery, Manure Bank and Management Agreement
 - → Preparing new Single Application





Benefits e-office Single Application


- ▶ 3 times less mistakes than on paper
 - → Overlaps
 - → Warnings must be solved
- Useful informations for farmers
 - → After completion SA: preliminary calculation of fertilisation standards
 - → Geospatial information:
 - X P classes
 - X Areas: nature areas, focus areas, agri-environmental areas,...
 - × Watercourses
 - X Soil type
 - × Erosion sensitive parcels
 - → Greening and ecological focus areas: calculated by e-office
 - → Double funding is excluded



Follow-up Single Application information

- Manure Bank
 - → Fertilisation standards
 - → Grant derogation
 - → Nitrate Residue
 - → Audit of farms and related actors
 - → Inspections on the field (transport, distance to watercourses, period of manure spreading,...)
 - → If needed measures, adaptations and sanctions (e.g. catch crops, transport measures, nutrient balance fines, other fines,...)
- Pillar I and II (Department and VLM)
 - → Inspections: farms, crops and field
 - → Payment Aid Application, AECM, Management Agreements
- Cross-compliances
