Feedback: CAP networks



- What are the main differences from current networking for a successful CAP network?
 - Balance and relevance (in relation to Pillar I and Pillar II, CAP objectives, stakeholders, themes)
 - Need for added value in relation to <u>all of the CAP objectives</u>
 - Possible diversity of MS level CAP Plans
 - Need to combine sectoral and territorial approaches / consider new stakeholders
 - Use common and simple language combined with more effective use of IT
 - More and more efficient working groups involving a broader range of stakeholders
 - New topics eco-schemes, sector specific interventions under Pillar I to consider
- How will we get there starting now including governance of the networks?
 - Start from early stages / involve stakeholders in planning the network / find out about specific needs
 - Rely on existing expertise / consider MS perspectives / broader thematic focus
 - Develop a common rural agenda
 - Do <u>not</u> overregulate / limit the scope of CAP networks
 - Communicate CAP network objectives effectively start at the networX conference
 - Do a `mapping` of different MS level network (governance) systems / develop a clear, simple intervention logic for the Network
 - Include the `network` theme in the Civil Dialogue Groups, discussions with MAs, etc for better preparation







Feedback: Innovation/ AKIS in the new CAP



- Farmers need strong, qualitative and neutral/independent advice
- AKIS is a concept with huge potential and it needs organisation to structure information flows – NRNs have experience but they need capacity building for this role (EU Network to build on lessons learned and support NRNs)
- We need to involve more private entities in AKIS
- How to keep it (AKIS) simple? How to extend it beyond agricultural production? How to reach farmers/involve them in AKIS?







Feedback: Introducing the Performance, Monitoring and Evaluation Framework



- Capacity Building (communication, guidance, information (on time)
- Analysis of stakeholders
- Practical testing (e.g. new set of indicators within current programming period)
- Facilitation of the exchange of information, experiences between MS \ MS and stakeholders (incl. presenting PEMF in MS)
