Vision

Innovative and sustainable agriculture and rural development through cohesive regional cooperation to achieve an improvement of rural livelihoods in SEE countries.

Mission

The Area Based Development (ABD) approach in the Western Balkans: a tool for rural development with up-scaling potential

Area Based Development (ABD) is an innovative approach enabling a breakthrough in sustainable economic growth by targeting specific geographical areas in cross-border regions, which are characterised by a set of common, complex development problems. It is considered an effective approach to facilitate sustainable growth in rural areas in decline. The approach uses a methodology that is inclusive, participatory, flexible, and ensures integration and coherence.

Objectives

The overall action focuses on three parallel processes:

- 1. Facilitation of **cross-border and regional cooperation and reconciliation** by providing mechanisms for legitimate, transparent and participatory processes of needs assessment, priority setting, and action planning in a particular region.
- 2. Contribution to **sustainable economic growth** of a region by facilitating the implementation of projects and by providing investment support to the sector with the highest added value for and catalytic effects on the rural economies.
- 3. Strengthening cooperation among public administrations and other public bodies, and **NGOs** in the field of local development and regional cooperation by building up local and regional cross-border capacities.


Grant Scheme' for the 'Pilot The enhancement of the competitiveness of small- and medium-scale producers

The 'Pilot Grant Scheme' largely follows the modalities of the support measures as implemented under the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) and the Agriculture and Rural Development component of the Instrument for Pre-Accession – (IPARD).

Its main goal is to enhance the competitiveness of small- and medium-scale producers by providing small grants for renewing production facilities and purchasing equipment to create new innovative products or to improve existing ones. In total, small grants of an approximate value of EUR 150 000 distributed among nine projects with 28 beneficiaries were successfully implemented.
