

Examples of expected achievements

- País Vasco's RDP will support knowledge transfer and innovation in agriculture, forestry and rural areas mainly through measures supporting training as more than 22 000 participants will be trained. There will also be support for 130 cooperation projects in the framework of the European Innovation Partnership for Agricultural Productivity and Sustainability.
- In terms of competitiveness of the agri-sector and sustainable forestry, some 19 % of farms will receive funding for investments focused on restructuring and modernisation.
- Nearly 3 % of farms will receive support for young farmers to set up their businesses.
- More than 14 % of farms (around 2 350 farms) will receive funding to participate in quality schemes, local markets and short supply chain distribution.
- Around 40 % of the EAFRD budget will be used for area-based payments to farmers for using environment/climate friendly
 management practices, including organic farming and nearly 13 % of farmland will come under management contracts to improve
 biodiversity.
- More than one third of farmland and forest land will be under contracts contributing to fostering carbon conservation and sequestration in agriculture and forestry.
- Nearly 53 % of the rural population will be affected by Local Development Strategies (LDS) funded under the LEADER approach creating around 530 new jobs.

Examples of key challenges

- A key challenge for rural areas in País Vasco is the ageing of the population which, coupled with young people leaving for urban areas, may lead to land abandonment in the region.
- Other weaknesses include the fact that the farm sector is dominated by farms with no employees, and the low qualification levels in rural areas.
- In addition Pais Vasco is a very mountainous region that makes mechanisation of agriculture and forestry processes difficult.


















Expenditure under Priority 4 is programmed for the priority as a whole, not for individual focus areas.
