Examples of expected achievements

- To promote lifelong learning the RDP will aim to provide training for 2 600 participants from the agricultural, food and forestry sectors.
- The RDP will also promote knowledge transfer and innovative practices, by supporting 15 cooperation projects in various fields.
- The programme will support modernization and development projects in about 1 000 farms (8 % of the total).
- The RDP will encourage the installation of young farmers aiming to achieving 700 additional farms managed by young managers (6 % of the total).
- Around 180 projects on quality certification systems for agricultural and food products will be supported.
- For the preservation of natural resources, agro-environment- climate measures will cover about 30 000 ha (9 % of the total agricultural area).
- The amount of about EUR 19 million will be invested to develop the supply and use of renewable energy in agriculture.
- The programme will support the implementation of Local Development Strategies (LDS) that will be carried out by 5 Local Action Groups (LAGs) bringing benefits to 500 000 people and generating 27 jobs.


Examples of key challenges

- The region although it has sufficient water resources, their quality differs between surface and groundwater due to agricultural and industrial pollution.
- Biodiversity is also under threat and there are also risks in terms of soil erosion.
- Besides the difficult economic conditions, agriculture in the region faces structural weaknesses such as the ageing of farm managers, pressure for land, the on average relatively small size of farms and similarly agri-food and forestry businesses are also particularly vulnerable.







3. Planned expenditure per priority


