

#### **Examples of expected achievements**

- The RDP will support demonstration and information activities including 20 cooperation projects, out of which 10 cooperation projects will be implemented under the European Innovation Partnership Agricultural Productivity and Sustainability.
- The programme will support about 3 500 farms (8 % of the total) to improve their economic and environmental performance.
- The setup of young farmers will be encouraged by the RDP so that an additional 2 400 farms are managed by young farmers (6 % of the total).
- Agro-environmental and climate measures will cover about 272 000 ha (18 % of the total agricultural area) addressing the need for preserving the biodiversity, water and soil resources in the region.
- The RDP will also support the conversion and maintenance of the organic agriculture on 5 % of the agricultural land.
- The reforestation of about 5 % of the damaged forest area due to catastrophic events in 2009 (storm Klaus) will be funded as to preserve forest resources and maintain forest carbon sequestration potential.
- About 10 % of programme resources will be used for improving access to basic services and infrastructure for 30 % of the rural
  population.
- 16 Local Action Groups (LAGs) will be supported to implement Local Development Strategies (LDS) covering about 70 % of the rural population.

#### **Examples of key challenges**

- Being the leading industrial employer in Aquitaine region, the agro-food sector has a high proportion of small businesses that do not allow optimum development of their activity, in terms of modernizing equipment and searching for new business opportunities.
- Another challenge is to promote the creation of added value from forest resources in the region and maintain jobs that cannot be relocated. Moreover the forests of the region are also a remarkable biodiversity reserve the RDP will help preserve.
- An important challenge for the Aquitaine RDP is to support initiatives favorable to the economic development of rural areas, such as
  tourism on which the region has great potential, and guarantee a minimum of services to the population in territories with less
  developed infrastructure.






