



Examples of expected achievements

- The RDP for Franche-Comté intends to support 1 200 farms (12 % of the total) in implementing modernization and development projects.
- The programme will support 1 600 young farmers' projects (16 % of holdings) throughout the programming period.
- It also aims to increase the added value of agricultural production by supporting 210 new organic farmers.
- Agri-environment-climate measures will cover about 6 % of the agricultural area, while changes in agricultural practices will be accompanied by about 170 non-productive investment projects linked to the achievement of agri-environmental objectives.
- The programme will finance 438 investment projects in order to foster the development of renewable energy, including biogas from waste and manure.
- Focus will be given on cooperation projects through the LEADER approach. 9 Local Development Strategies (LDS) will be supported by Local Action Groups (LAGs) covering 32 % of the rural population.

Examples of key challenges

- Almost all of the region's agricultural land is classified as area facing natural constraints (96 % of the UAA of which about 28 % are mountain areas and 68% other areas with natural constraints).
- Agriculture and food processing are key sectors for the region's economy. The weight of the primary sector in the economy of the region is more important than the national average in terms of gross value added and employment.





Expenditure under Priority 4 is programmed for the priority as a whole, not for individual focus areas.
