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

Examples of expected achievements

- To cover the general lack of technical knowledge and management skills of farmers, the programme will provide training, information and demonstration activities with the aim of achieving about 1 100 participants.
- Also, 93 cooperation projects will be supported, including operational groups under the European Innovation Partnership (EIP) on Agricultural Productivity and Sustainability.
- The RDP intends to support 350 farms (about 6 % of the total) on modernization and development projects to help them increase their competitiveness and quality of production.
- · About 20 % of agribusiness industries will be supported to improve their production processes and marketing.
- · Approximately 3.5 % of farms will benefit from financing for their commitment in steps towards improved quality production.
- About 25 % of the agricultural area (6 400 hectares) will be under agri-environment-climate contracts for the reduction of water and soil agricultural footprint.
- The RDP will also promote the conversion and maintenance of organic farming on 3 000 ha (0.1 % of the agricultural land).
- Under LEADER, 5 Local Action Groups (LAGs) will be financed and their Local Development Strategies (LDS) will benefit almost 90 %
 of the Guyanese population and create 35 jobs.

Examples of key challenges

- Farmers suffer from a strong dependence of agricultural inputs (products, pesticides, fertilizers, animal feed, etc.).
- About 90 % of wood production is intended for the domestic market. However, the production is uncompetitive and faces
 competition from imported products against which the Guyanese production confronts very high production costs.
- Guyane still faces basic needs in rural infrastructure. This includes housing, development of infrastructure and facilities, transport network, electricity, drinking water supply, treatment of wastewater and waste, health and social needs.





Breakdown of FA budget by measure (%)











3. Planned expenditure per priority



Expenditure under Priority 4 is programmed for the priority as a whole, not for individual focus areas.
