

`Ideal` elements of TNC

 Explains the concept of TNC project, networking, budget allocation to TNC, selection, information sharing among MAs, preparatory support, project selection and approval **Common** templates

- Generic, draft template for a cooperation agreement
- Cooperation agreement template used in UK-Scotland
- Project information sheet template developed in Spain

## Common definitions - proposals

- Relating to `joint actions` and common costs
- Generic framework and guidance
- Examples of categories

Examples of relevant practice

- a preparatory technical support information template (UK-SCO),
- preparatory support application in AT, FI, UK-NIE, PT;
- NRN support in FI, ES, IE, UK-NIE, EL;
- the `LEAD MA/PA` concept (DE),
- NIE cooperation guidance,
- funding agreements between LAGs in UK-SCO,
- EMMF Cooperation landscape


