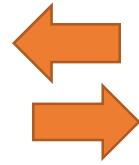

What to avoid – barriers - blockages

- Supply led rather than led by business needs
- Overlaps and gaps in provision
- Rigid demarcation, heavy eligibility rules obstacles to building linkages
- Difficulties in combining and coordinating calls and measures
- Fixed grant led schemes not related to market needs
- Difficulty in dealing with small scale projects, risky and uncertain projects
- Long delays – heavy administrative costs.....

- **New ways of adding and retaining value from local assets**
- **Strengthening local value chains + productive networks**
- **Making the most of new technologies**
- **Creative solutions to emerging challenges**
- **A general environment for starting and scaling new businesses**

Explore how to achieve

- **Synergies with other programmes and funds, e.g. EAFRD, ERDF, ESF, National**
- **Synergy between measures, e.g. Knowledge transfer + Investment Measures**
- **Designing and implementing measures in ways that meet business needs.**

Smart RDPs create space for

- **Inspiration for new creative business ideas**
- **Access to knowledge and peer to peer learning**
- **Flexible finance**
- **Support for networking and cooperation**
- **Access to key services (eg broadband)**
