Local Fibre Networks in Sweden

- Alternative to the incumbent
- 93 % owned by the municipal;
 - 38 % as apart of the local utility company
 - 28 % as a stock company
 - 27 % as a direct administration
- Business conditions
- No discrimination "open networks"
- Enable hundreds of different service providers
- App 50 % of the fibre access network
- Lively fibre and capacity market
- Common SLA, business agreements, systems and purchasing
- Increasing competition, new actors entered


