



A regional network of co-working spaces to attract and retain entrepreneurs in rural Catalonia





Ten LEADER groups in Catalonia, Spain have engaged in a strategic cooperation project to build a network of 16 co-working spaces in rural areas.

Their aim is to provide professionals with a means to begin their working lives locally, to encourage collaborative ways of working, and to attract or retain other professionals for longer periods through teleworking.

Most of the physical spaces were funded locally through LEADER and/or other sources. The **COWOCAT cooperation project** brought these spaces together into a regional network, trained project promotors, created a common digital platform and built links with urban co-working spaces.

The network has now expanded through a new **transnational cooperation project** with partners involved in co-working from Belgium, France, Germany, Ireland and the UK.

## Main results

- 1. 16 co-working spaces have been created from 2014 to 2018.
- 2. More than 130 professionals are linked to the co-working spaces.
- 3. Evidence of families prolonging their stays in rural areas as a result of being able to connect to work via a co-working space
- 4. Mutual learning and peer exchange between the local centres.
- 5. Joint promotion of the potential of co-working to urban areas and a further round of transnational cooperation
