


Possible focus:

- look at opportunities offered by digital technologies for nutrient management




Water Quality

 - tools at farm level




Air quality

 - manure management




Animal welfare

- Implementation is going on














Non chemical weed management




Possible focus:

- implementation is going on














New avenues for diversification - new business models on the farm




Possible focus:

- new products, new markets and related logistics




New feed for livestock





 - meat also looking at the entire chain (e.g. focus mycotoxins)















EIP implementation – Putting Operational group results into practice
