- The LTVRA outlines main priority areas for rural action to achieve the common ambition by 2040






- Challenges vary across the EU and are multifaceted.

- Call for an enabling environment that supports action and development to revitalise rural areas



Enabling factors for rural revitalisation

- Holistic and place-based strategies tuned to the local context.
- Integrated governance structures
- Policy alignment
- Territorial cooperation
- Flexible and adequate funding
- Monitoring and evaluation





Vertical integration and coordination

- Multilevel and inclusive governance structures
- Flexibility to adapt higher level strategies to the local context
- Simplified access to funding for local actors
- Communication and building new rural narratives







- Stakeholder inclusion in decision making
- Local animation and facilitation
- Enhance local capacity
- Knowledge sharing and networking
