





Planetary boundaries



If 5% of European citizens engaged as beneficiaries of community-based initiatives similar to the ones sampled, almost 85% of the EU-28 countries would meet the target of reducing GHG emissions by 20% by 2020 (considering the food/agriculture, waste, energy and transport domains).
