# THE MAIN PRIORITIES OF THE FUTURE CAP

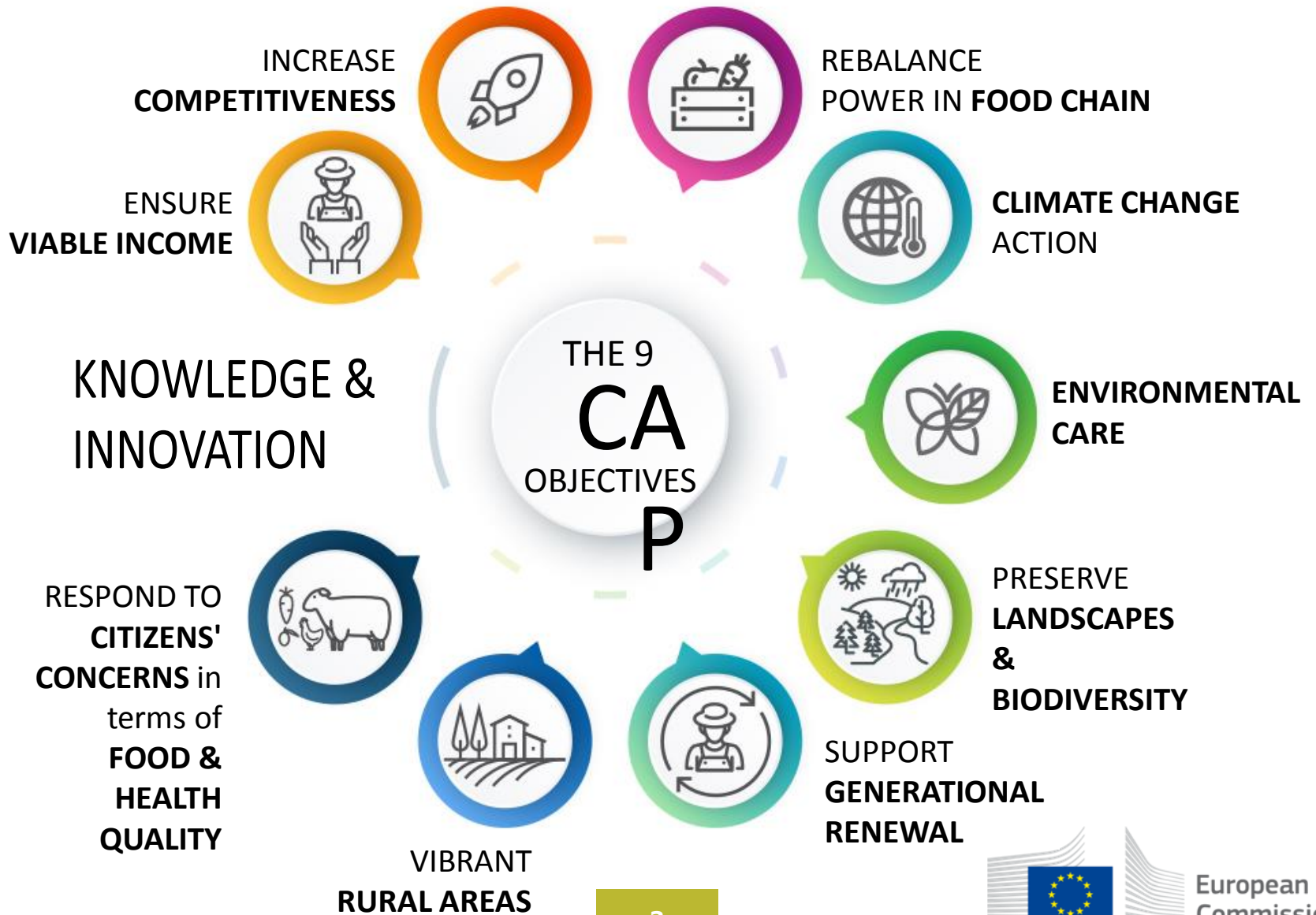
1. The **modernisation** and **simplification** of the policy framework

4. The strengthening of **environmental and climate action**

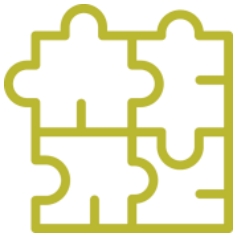


5. Growth and jobs in **rural areas** and encouraging **generational renewal**
6. The response to **citizens' concerns** on sustainable agricultural production

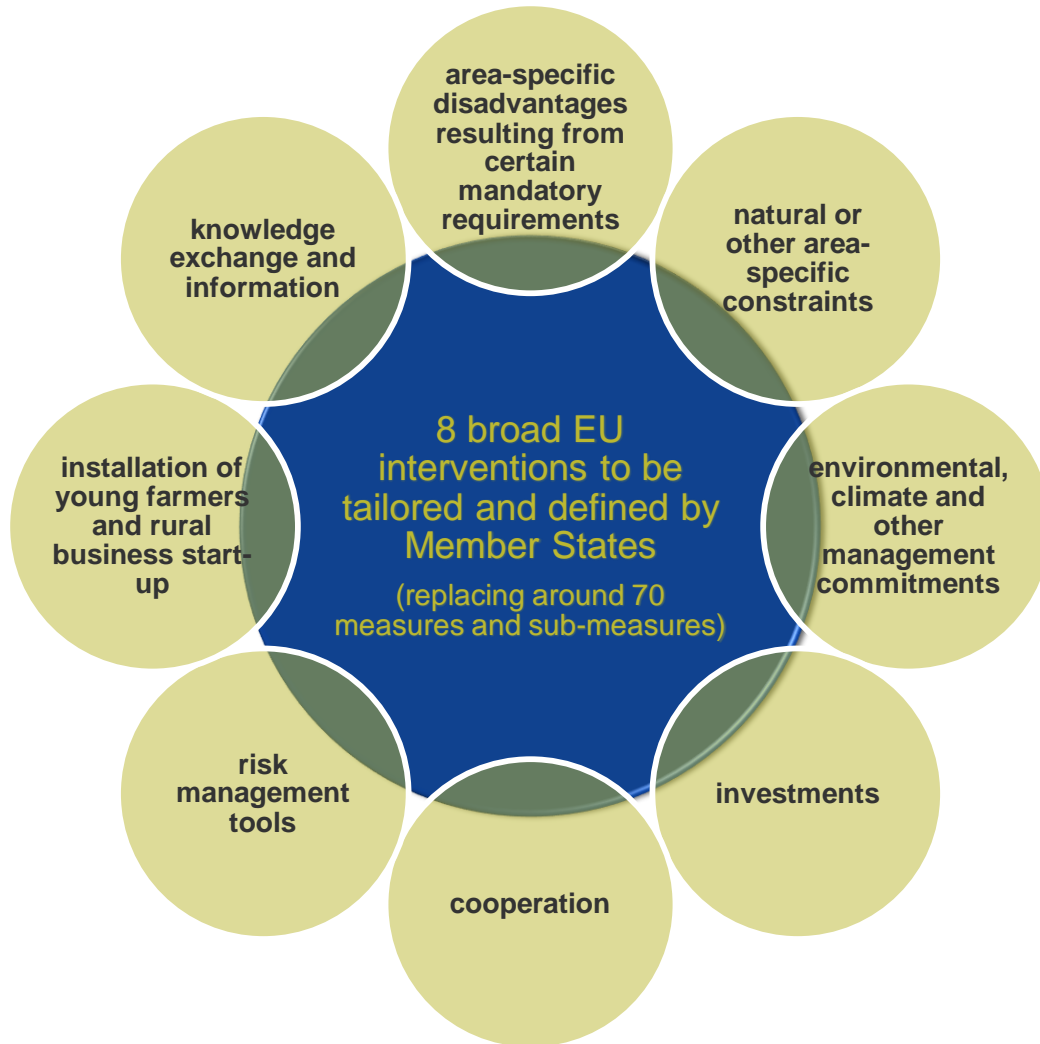

# RURAL DEVELOPMENT



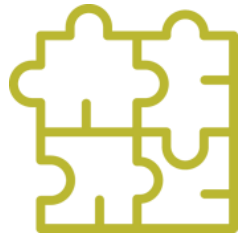
## KEY FEATURES

Minimum budget ring-fencing of **total EAFRD** contribution:

- **30%** for interventions addressing the three environmental/ climate objectives
- **5%** for LEADER

Possibility of using **financial instruments** (incl. working capital), also in combination with grants

**Digitisation strategy, YF strategy, Risk Management Strategy to be included in the CAP plan**
