
THE MAIN PRIORITIES OF THE FUTURE CAP

- 2. Innovation and knowledge for tomorrow's agriculture and rural areas
- 3. The **resilience** of European agriculture, with a more equitable & more efficient support through a better targeting of aids
- 4. The strengthening of environmental and climate action




- 5. Growth and jobs in rural areas and encouraging generational renewal
- 6. The response to **citizens' concerns** on sustainable agricultural production









KEY FEATURES

Minimum budget ringfencing of **total EAFRD** contribution:

- 30% for interventions addressing the three environmental/ climate objectives
- 5% for LEADER

Possibility of using financial instruments (incl. working capital), also in combination with grants
