

## **STATE OF PLAY OF THE CAP PROPOSAL**

### Legal proposals for the CAP post 2020 adopted by the Commission on 1 June 2018

### Discussions as part of legislative procedure with the Council and the **European Parliament ongoing**

**Proposal provides for a date of application as of 1 January 2021**

## **SMART VILLAGES IN THE FUTURE CAP**

### Smart Villages in the CAP proposal

- Referred to in recital (45) on support for cooperation
- <u>Targets to be set for Smart Villages, based on Result Indicator 33</u>: "Rural population covered by a supported Smart Villages strategy"

### The proposal in general

- Strong focus on innovation and digitisation of agriculture and rural areas Legal framework provides for more flexibility for Member States to design simple, relevant interventions according to national/regional/local context



More **flexibility**, **fewer** rules ...








## SUPPORT THROUGH THE CAP STRATEGIC PLAN

### Member States design interventions and set targets in CAP Strategic Plans

- According to SWOT analysis and assessment of needs
- Contributing to one or more of the 9 CAP objectives



*E. g. interventions under Cooperation (incl. LEADER) possibly combined with other interventions, such as digital solutions, knowledge exchange and information, investments...*



- Other forms of cooperation



## **"OTHER FORMS OF COOPERATION"**

### Flexibility for Member States to define interventions according to varying contexts


- Support may cover up to 100 % of eligible costs for the cooperation
- Or cooperation only, in combination with other CAP Strategic Plan interventions
- Eligibility criteria (e. g. regarding the strategy) to be defined by MS

### **Don't forget current** possibilities in rural development!

Cooperation operations may include also animation and project implementation (elements) similar to other types of interventions according to those rules, e. g. investments)



## **SMART VILLAGE SUCCESS FACTORS VS. LEADER**



- Has it all to be the main vehicle ...
- on the condition that all the features are present.
- (bigger scale investments, regulatory framework, coordination)



• Yet, to play to its full potential it needs to be complemented by enabling environment
