## Villages of the future

## Final Agenda of the 8th meeting

### 6 June 2019

#### Lormes, France

The Thematic Group (TG) meeting on Smart Villages takes place in Lormes, 'a village of the future' in Burgundy, France on  $6^{th}$  June. It is organised back to back with a <u>conference</u> on '*Co-creating Digital Transformation*' organised by the Interreg project <u>ERUDITE</u> which will take place in Dijon (France) on  $4^{th}$  June and includes study visits on 5th June 2019.

Participants have three options: 1) attending only the TG meeting on 6 June; 2) attending also the field visits on the 5 June to a major new rural digital and redevelopment hub and to a rural focussed research and innovation centre; 3) attending also the ERUDITE Conference on 4 June which will showcase a wide range of rural digital projects and tools for co-designing rural digital services.

#### Aims of the TG meeting:

The specific objectives of the 8<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Thematic Group are:

- To explore 'on site' how a specific village (Lormes, Burgundy) has embarked on a participative process to co-design a 'village of the future' and the way they have used different aspects of the local 'digital ecosystem' to support their journey, in the context of the French approach to digitising rural areas.
- To provide a picture of similar initiatives and plans for developing local digital ecosystems in other Member States.
- To allow participants to learn from these initiatives and to share lessons and **methodological** approaches for developing local digital ecosystems.
- To exchange views about the **future needs** to be addressed by the ENRD Thematic Working Group on Smart Villages.
