- ✓ improving continuously networking activities
- ✓ demonstrating the added value of networking










### **NRN** Meeting in Latvia

## Discussion points during meeting

- Common network statistics ("output indicators"): what data to collect collectively to demonstrate outputs of NRNs at the European level?
- How to make network statistics meaningful (SMART) & aligned with mandatory data collection?
- How to work together/ assist NRNs in carrying out qualitative selfassessment (with focus on results)?









#### Main challenges for NRNs

- Quantitative indicators are often not meaningful: focus on quality rather than quantity
- Defining and collecting common network statistics – diversity of networks
- Identifying useful methods for qualitative assessment (results) – great interest for NRNs
- Scope and interest for joint working among NRNs & European Networks
