#### Model in a nutshell



- Organic certification
- 1.2 hectares of diversified vegetable market gardens (including 1000m2 of unheated polytunnels)
- Conversion to permanent raised beds, French intensive vegetable farming (2016)
- 250 laying hens  $\rightarrow$  400 hens (2017)
- 1 apprentice or 1.5 FTE seasonal workers







#### **Distinguishing characteristics**



- Technophiles
- Open Source Farming
- Very little reliance on advisory services
- Facilitation
- Commitment to new sharing economy, crowdfunding

# Atypical farmers, fairly typical new entrants

- Non-farming backgrounds, no farming training
- Bringing an abandoned subsistence farm back to life (2010)
- Starting modestly, managing growth incrementally and slowly















- Not limited by conventional wisdom
- Very little debt => more freedom for experimentation
- Local interest and commitment to farming renewal









- Started with CSAs, market in village
- Founding cooperative of local organic farms
- Maintaining excellent relationships with all of our clients
- Taking account of fragmented demand
- Selling surpluses

- Managing very high consumer demand
- Scaling back to focus on essentials
- Finding better production -costs balance
- . Learning from failures
- . Flexibility to adapt
- Improving ergonomics

- When you're an endangered species, you need to be exceptional

## Recommendations



- Incentives to farmers for training potential new entrants on the job
- Innovative financing for local authorities making land available to new entrants
- Remove perverse incentives from CAP which are barriers to new entrants
- Small grants to help overcome barriers to startup, but not enough rope to hang yourself with..
