The Genesis

2012 Macra na Feirme Study on Land Mobility and Succession in Ireland found:

- 26% of farmers over the age of 65
- 48% of full time farmers had no identified farming successor





Such a service needs significant support to ensure success

- To encourage engagement and action otherwise the do nothing option prevails
- 2. Facilitating Collaborations requires significant time and efforts
 - Identify suitable persons
 - Ensure the farm plan and negotiated arrangement are workable, sustainable and appropriate.

Lessons Learned

- Service works as evidenced by delivery
- Needs greater State/EU Support
- In Ireland, no Startup Business Aid (Installation Aid)
- Land Mobility Schemes included in EU Commission Legislative proposals, now needs inclusion in MS CAP 2020Strategic Plans
